Potential to Boost Exports of Value-Added Vietnamese Pangasius Products to Malaysia Vietnamese pangasius products consistently rank at the top of the list of preferred white fish in

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many markets, and Malaysia is no exception. As part of ASEAN, one of the largest free trade regions

Additionally, exports of other dried/frozen pangasius products (whole fish, cut pieces, etc.) totaled over \$3 million in the first ten months of this year, marking a 19% rise year-over-year. In the first ten months of 2024, exports of value-added pangasius products to Malaysia reached over \$1.5 million, a 115% increase compared to the same period last year. 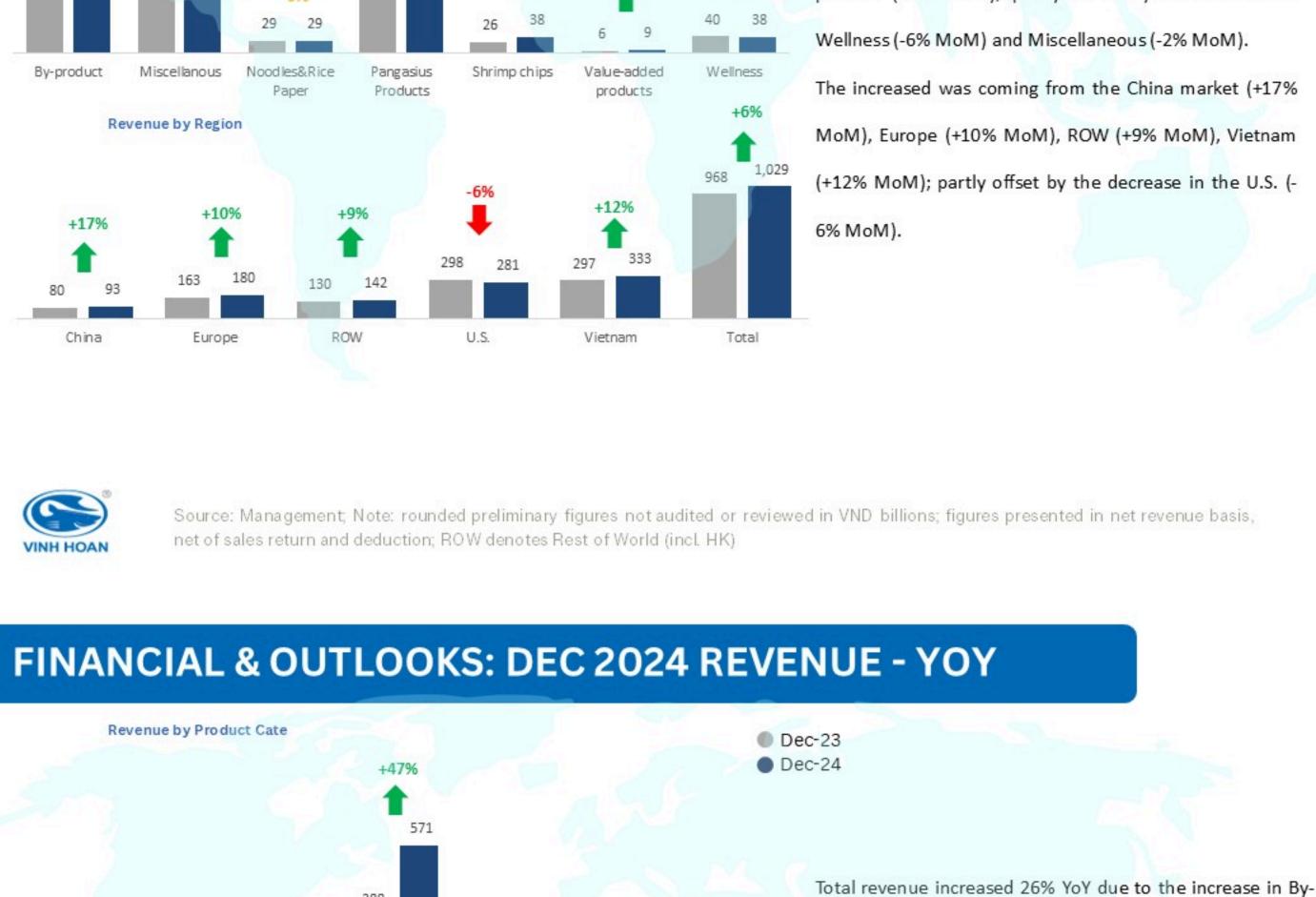
